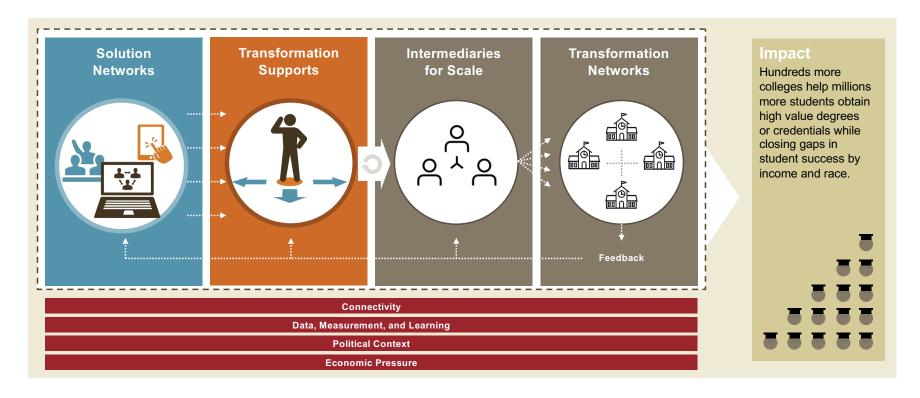
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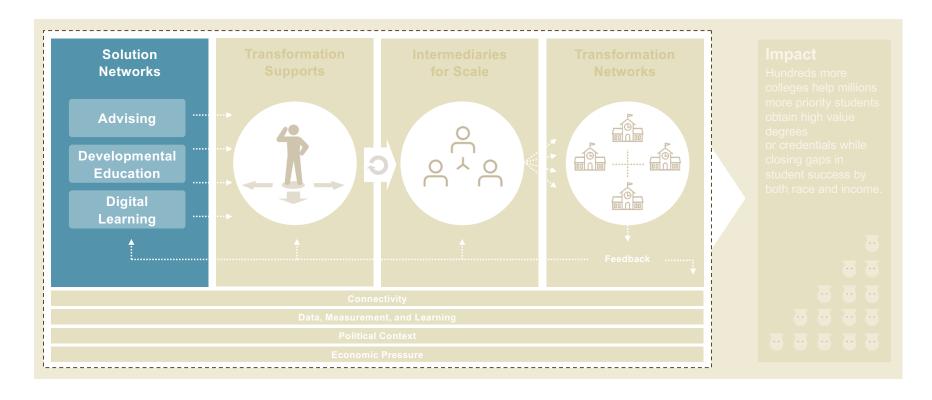

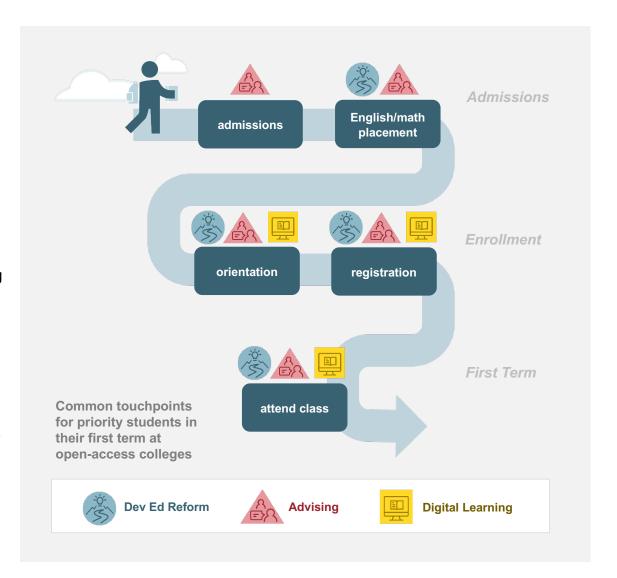

# THREE SOLUTIONS TO SUPPORT STUDENT SUCCESS

We have chosen to focus on **Developmental Education Reform**, **Advising**, and **Digital Learning** as they play complementary roles
and involve deep institutional capacity-building
that spans the student journey from
matriculation to transfer and graduation.

They are expected to maximize the likelihood of success for our priority student populations by improving Key Performance Indicators including course completion ratio, gateway course completion, 1st-year credit accumulation, program of study selection, 1st-year retention rate, and student ROI.

### **Solution Networks:**

A connected community of practice of key stakeholders that collectively advance and maintain the delivery of a solution, sustained by institutional transformation, among institutions of higher education to support success for students who are Black, Latino, Indigenous, or from lowincome backgrounds.

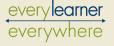

Demonstrated commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion indicated by representative leadership and staff for the project, and other organizational leadership (i.e., board or an advisory group)

Experience developing a shared research agenda, conducting research, and disseminating findings

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# **SD&D PARTNERS IN CONTEXT OF THIS STRATEGY:** DEEP DIVES TO FOLLOW (OR PUBLISHED AS AN ONBOARDING DOCUMENT)



As areas of our strategy overlap, our partners may occupy multiple areas within the strategy

### For instance:

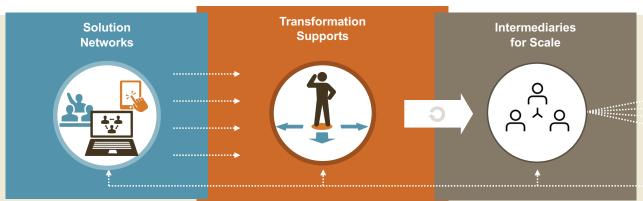
- While the Frontier Set Intermediaries are supporting their institutions in the SD&D context, they are also key contributors to the "Transformation Supports"
- Additionally, individual partners may also serve multiple roles (e.g. APLU as a FSI, Intermediary for Scale and member of a Solution network)

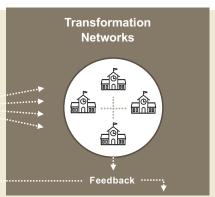
The greatest opportunity for clarity is in the Transformation Supports, as we are still learning how to leverage these offerings

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### **INSTITUTIONAL TRANSFORMATION AT SCALE: HIGH-LEVEL ROLES**

The process of service design and delivery is not linear, but occurs through iterative feedback loops





Solution Networks are built of Researchers, Providers and Intermediaries to develop and provide services

- These "Transformation Supports" are leveraged by both Solution Networks and Intermediaries for Scale, and include building capacities, running diagnostics and integrating services
- Some support partners will also be providing services (e.g., capacities / pathways)
- Intermediaries for Scale leverage transformation supports to facilitate this process and brokering with Solution Networks
- Intermediaries for Scale will work with networks or cohorts of institutions to diagnose needs and express a requests
- IFS shares needs and institutional contexts with Solution Networks, positioned to provide "transformation supports"
- Solution Network identifies appropriate providers to deliver solutions to IFS institutions
- Intermediaries partner through a network to support institutions (e.g., Frontier Set, Intermediaries for Scale)
- Institutions receive services via their intermediaries from solutions, capacity, and pathways providers based on cohort needs
